



Conroe Pan American Round Table Scholarship

Scholarship Guidelines

This scholarship is awarded annually by the Pan American Round Table of Conroe to assist a female student from Montgomery County in pursuing her studies in the state of Texas.

Applicant Qualifications:

An applicant must be a female high school senior or college student who is a U.S. citizen and a resident of Montgomery County. She must plan to attend or be enrolled in a college or university in Texas. The high schools are limited to Conroe High School, Caney Creek High School, Hauke High School. The current recipient has priority to the PART scholarship.

Application Requirements:

- 1) Completed application form.
- 2) Two letters of recommendation, one of which is from a teacher/professor at the institution in which she is currently enrolled. The letters should describe the applicant's academic ability, potential for success in her chosen field, and desirability as a candidate for the scholarship.
- 3) A cumulative transcript through the end of the latest semester.
- 4) The Project-Scholarship Committee Chairman (Riki Dewey, 737 River Plantation Dr., Conroe, TX 77302, rikidewey@hotmail.com) must receive the completed application form, two letters of recommendation, and a cumulative transcript postmarked by the deadline, of April 1 of the current year.

Terms of Scholarship:

- 1) The **Conroe Pan American Round Table Scholarship is a grant of at least \$1,000** for one year of study at a Texas university, paid in installments of one-half per semester, or one-third per trimester, depending upon the calendar at the academic institution of the recipient. The grant is usually \$1,000, but in some years it might be greater if funds are available.
- 2) At the beginning of each semester, the appropriate sum due the recipient will be sent, via check, to the scholarship recipient's college or university.
- 3) If the recipient fails to enroll in any term of the year for which the scholarship was granted, the sum of money will be held by the Pan American Round Table of Conroe.
- 4) The recipient is responsible for maintaining a "B" (3.0) grade point average, and sending verification of each term's grades to the Conroe Pan American Round Table.
- 5) The scholarship recipient will be asked to provide a photo for use in the Conroe Pan American Round Table publication and in *Panamericana Texana*.
