## 2018-2019 Annual Report

This past year, we were treated to some excellent programming, thanks to the efforts of Michelle Locke, our 1<sup>st</sup> Associate Director and Program Chair. In September, **Maestro Hector Guzman**, new Director of the Corpus Christi Symphony Orchestra, provided us with an entertaining program, including some lively piano playing. The XXXVI Alliance Convention was held in Cochabamba, Bolivia October 17-21, so our October meeting was held on October 23<sup>rd</sup>. **Attendees from the Corpus Table** gave a presentation about the Cochabamba conference during the October meeting. In November, **Dr. Erin McComb** spoke about Lieutenant Colonel Olga Custodio and her Quest to Democratize the Sky". In January, a representative of the **Port of Corpus Christi** gave a presentation on the current state of the Port of Corpus Christi and upcoming expansion. February was a new and exciting type of program. We had a tamale making demonstration by **Sandra Vasquez** and associates at the Galvan House in Heritage Park.

Section 10. The Scholarship Chairman shall be responsible for gathering information about possible recipients of scholarships and for preparing recommendations for the grants and expenditures for scholarships.

### ARTICLE II - MEETINGS

Section 1. Regular meetings shall be held on the third Tuesday of each month (except June, July, and August) at 11 a.m. unless otherwise stated in the yearbook.

Section 2. Special meetings may be called at the discretion of the Director or upon written request of five (5) members.

Section 3. PART shall adopt, each year, a policy concerning reservations. Unless otherwise decided, each member shall be responsible for the cost of her lunch, unless reservation is cancelled before 1 p.m. on the Friday preceding the Tuesday meeting.

### ARTICLE III - CONVENTIONS

Section 1. Registration fees shall be paid for voting delegates to the Biennial Pan American Round Table Texas State Convention and to the Biennial Pan American Round Table Alliance Convention.

### ARTICLE IV - CHANGES AND AMENDMENTS

Section 1. This Constitution and these Bylaws may be amended in whole or in part by a two-thirds majority vote of Active Members present at any regular meeting, due notice of said amendment having been given at a previous regular meeting, or may be amended at a called meeting provided written notice of said amendment has been sent to each member at least fifteen (15) days prior to said meeting and upon a two-thirds majority vote of active members present at such meeting.

Section 2. Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised, shall be the authority for parliamentary procedure during the meeting of the Round Table.

### Standing Rule

A Standing Rule defines the details of administration and delineates the specific procedures which govern the day-to-day operation of an organization. Standing rules are subject to more frequent changes than bylaws and can be suspended. Standing rules are voted on by the Board of Directors.

1. Memorials in the amount of \$25 are to be given to the Table's local Scholarship Fund upon the death of a Table member and/or her spouse.

2. The enforcement of attendance rulings will be implemented by the elected officers.
