



Pan American Round Tables of Texas San Antonio Scholarship Guidelines

Applicant Qualifications

An applicant must be a female student (undergraduate sophomore or any level graduate student) enrolled in an accredited public or private college or university in Bexar County, Texas. The student may be a U.S. Citizen, lawful permanent resident of the U.S., or a foreign student from a country in the Western Hemisphere.

Application Requirements

1. Complete application and photo consent form
2. A one or two page essay outlining educational goals, accomplishments, and how post-graduation plans will benefit women and children of the Western Hemisphere
3. Submit an official transcript which shows a 3.0 average or better (on a 4.0 scale).
4. Evidence of current enrollment and financial need
5. A short biography
6. One letter of support from the student's academic advisor to the PARTT-SA Scholarship Committee Chairperson
7. If possible, attend the PARTT-SA Scholarship Luncheon, honoring annual recipient(s) and advisor(s)
8. Submit all requested information, by the deadline, 3/31/17, via the U.S. Postal Service to:

Terms of Scholarship

The PARTT-SA scholarship is given annually, a minimum of \$1,000 (which could be \$5,000, if funds are available). If the recipient fails to enroll in any term of the year for which the scholarship was granted, the sum of money will be held by PARTT-SA. The student is responsible for maintaining a "B" (3.0) grade point average and sending verification of each term's grades to the PARTT-SA Chair. The scholarship recipient will be asked to provide a photograph for use in the PARTT-SA publication and in *Panamerican Texana*.

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
