The table provides scholarships to four graduating seniors each year. The scholarships are of \$800.00 from the Neil Kein Guerra Scholarship Fund set up in 1953, and \$800.00 from The American Association of University Women Scholarship donation provided on June 1st 2004. The table also donates \$250.00 to Roma High School Mariachi Program and \$250.00 to the Pan American Student Forum of Rio Grande City High School with a yearly total of \$2,100.00.

Officers and members attend different events and activities in the community, as well as visiting other tables when possible. A festive posada is organized every other year for Christmas and have the honor of inviting the surrounding tables and State Officers giving us an opportunity to visit with each other.
