In September 2018, I sent packets to the Financial Aid Office, Study Abroad Advisors and International Student Advisors of all Texas colleges and universities with the applications for the Florence Terry Griswold Scholarships I and II. The submission deadline cited was January 31, 2019.

I received a total of nineteen qualified applications for Scholarship I and six qualified application for Scholarship II. Two received applications were disqualified for failure to include all required documentation

These scholarships are made available thru the dues from the Texas tables and Honorariums and Memorials. The donations will be acknowledged to both the donor and the person honored.


The committee and the Board of Trustees received copies of all the applications and rated them and selected the best applicants to receive the scholarship.
