Before the outbreak of this pandemic, the McAllen Convention Organizing Committee had already begun planning the convention at the new McAllen Convention Center and to negotiate room rates with several hotels in the area for the convention to be held April 8-11, 2021.

At the Zoom State Board Meeting held on June 13, 2020, I stressed that we would wait until January 2021 to decide whether to continue with preparations for the State Convention to convene as planned. However, in light of what is now happening in Texas, the State Board has voted to extend the term of the current board for 1 year to April 2022. Hold the State Convention in McAllen in April 2022 at which new officers would be elected to serve for a 3-year term in order to return conventions to odd numbered years.
