The Rio Grande City - Roma Pan American Round Table is made up of 44 active members, 5 Sustaining members, and 2 Charter members. Regular meetings are held six times a year on the second Wednesday of September through May. At every meeting we recognize 2 student guests from Rio Grande City High School and Roma High School. The students introduce themselves and talk about their accomplishments, hobbies, goals and sometimes entertain our members with their talents.

Our members represent a country on which they provide a program. On every other year in December our program is on Mexico, its Christmas traditions and customs. We invite our neighboring Tables from the Rio Grande Valley and North of Mexico. We celebrate with a traditional Posada, where we experience the songs and flavor the traditional food. We reenact the Nativity with music and end the Celebration with the breaking of the Piñata.

The Pan American Student Forum was also part of our December 2007 posada, where they dressed in traditional Mexican dresses and catered to our members and guests.
